COURSE DESCRIPTION

If you are like most motor officers, your formal training focused on the operation of your motorcycle at slow speeds within limited spaces. In reality, the majority of your routine patrol day is spent at higher speeds, not at low speeds in a parking lot. Having a complete understanding of all the issues involved in high speed cornering is necessary to help you develop the riding techniques required to make you a proficient rider at higher speeds. The **Total Control Advanced Riding Clinic addresses** this critical training need for certified motor officers. This curriculum covers the key issues involved in cornering; traction management, mental state, throttle control, visual acuity, line selection, body position and proper suspension adjustment. All of these issues are discussed thoroughly in the classroom before being applied both static and in a controlled speed environment to facilitate learning and maximize officer safety.

WHERE

The **Total Control Advanced Riding Clinic** is conducted in a one day session at the DPS Emergency Vehicle Operations Center in **Florence, TX**. Motor officers are required to take the class on their normally assigned duty motorcycle and wear their uniform protective gear, including helmet, jacket and gloves.

CREDIT

8 hours of TCLEOSE credit is given for the course.
